Subject: Residential visit to Barcelona for Year 9 (MAT) (Mathematics) pupils

Mrs Thomas will allow you to leave school at 12.20 on Wednesday 23rd to shower, change and get your suitcase. Enjoy a large lunch in the canteen or at home, as we will only be able to grab what's on offer at the airport!

Bring your case to room 022 (my room) before **2.30** as we will go from lesson 5 (maths) to the bus. **DO NOT FORGET YOUR PASSPORT.**

EasyJet Cabin Baggage

Passengers are permitted to bring **one** piece of **hand luggage** as a carry on that will travel with them in the cabin. There are no weight restrictions on this baggage, however, it must be no bigger than **56cm x 45cm x 25cm** including handles and wheels.

Liquids. You can only carry **liquids**, aerosols, toothpaste, perfumes and gels in containers of **100ml** or less, when you pass through security. They should all fit into one transparent, re-sealable 20cm x 20cm bag. In total each customer can carry a maximum of 1,000ml through security. (Duty free items can be purchased outside of the allowance on both flights but you should keep the receipt and the airport bag)

All **medication** should come with the original packaging. Please can you let me know about any prescribed medication that needs to be taken whilst away especially any needles or liquids that are greater than 100ml.

Money the currency in Spain is **Euros**. I would recommend a small amount of cash to purchase drinks/ice creams. Most places will take a debit card and if possible this would be the safest way to spend money. Like any other major tourist city Barcelona can have a problem with pick pockets.

Mobile Phones. Spain is a Go Roam in Europe destination and your allowance should be the same as in Wales but please check with your net-work providers to avoid any unexpected bills.

Student photos I'm sure we would all like some pictures of the trip to share but please can you let me know via email if you do not consent.

All pupils will be placed in groups and will have a member of staff assigned to them. These groups are based on the rooms you are sleeping in. When we need to depart anywhere on the trip the member of staff will take responsibility for their register. Please stay with this group when walking about in Barcelona.
