<u>Class Dojo</u>

Class Dojo is a communication app and website. It connects primary school teachers, students and families through communication features, such as a feed for photos and videos to share learning experiences from throughout the day.

Parents can message teaching staff which can be translated if required to support home-school learning. Each learner is provided with a profile including a work portfolio to share their experiences and achievements which can be rewarded individually, in groups or as a whole class.



<u>MyMaths</u>

MyMaths is an interactive online teaching and homework subscription website for schools that builds pupil engagement and consolidates maths knowledge. This is used by KS2 pupils.



<u>Hwb</u>

Hwb is a website and collection of online tools provided to all schools in Wales by the Welsh Government.

Through the Hwb website you can access Office 365, Google Classroom, Just 2 Easy and lots more resources and programmes. Log on to your child/children's account to communicate and collaborate with your school community.

Reading Eggs is the online phonics reading program that helps children learn to read and then progresses to Reading Express. Reading Express makes reading real books, improving spelling skills and building reading comprehension highly. There are hundreds of online reading lessons, phonics games and books for ages 2-13.

<u>Maths Seeds</u>

Maths Seeds is used in the FP to consolidate core maths and problem solving skills needed to be successful at school with fun, highly interactive and rewarding lessons. Math seeds combines structured lessons with fun motivational elements that keep children engaged and keen to learn.

Blended learning is an approach to education that combines online educational materials and opportunities for interaction online with traditional place-based classroom methods.

As part of our blended learning approach we use a range of digital platforms that form our Ebbw Fawr Digital Toolkit.

Pupils will be taught how to access and use these platforms at school with the aim that they can independently access them at home.

Pupils all have a log in card with all their usernames and passwords on them.

Accelerated Reader is a widely used computer program to help students and teachers gauge the level at which children can read independently. Children choose their own book, from the vast selection available from Renaissance, and take a quiz on the computer to show that they have correctly understood the contents of the book.
